



BlindShell Classic 3 does even more than before



The easy-to-use, accessible mobile phone has been upgraded to allow you to do even more. New features for the BlindShell Classic 3 are the Tandem app, third-party app support, and Luna, the virtual assistant.

It still has large, black tactile keypad buttons with bold, high-contrast white text, and you can still control your BlindShell phone using just your voice and simple commands, but now it's easier to connect with loved ones and use your phone.

The Tandem app was designed by the BlindShell team specifically for blind and partially sighted users and keeps you connected with family and friends anytime, anywhere. Tandem also allows loved ones to assist you remotely with phone settings or more complex apps. Friends and family can download Tandem to their iOS and Android devices to connect to you.

For third-party apps you can use the touchscreen (please note, the touchscreen only works with third-party apps) or you can use the



keypad if you prefer. And you can use Luna, the virtual AI assistant, to manage reminders, answer questions and simplify everyday tasks. (Your phone must be connected to the internet to use Luna).

BlindShell Classic 3 also has a loud speaker so that you won't miss a call or alert, even in noisy environments; 3GB of RAM for quick, smooth operation; 32GB of internal storage; a long-life, large-capacity battery with up to 96 hours of battery life; USB-C charging port and charging cradle for ease of charging at home or on the go.


This feature-packed phone also lets you stay in touch with friends and family via WhatsApp; watch your favourite videos on the YouTube app; browse the web; download apps from the BlindShell app catalogue and set up easy, touch-of-a-button access to your favourites.

You can also make conference calls, use the SOS button to contact your assigned emergency contact; use Facebook Messenger; play Pexeso, Hangman, or use the dice roller; listen to books, music or internet radio; manage email; set an alarm; check your calendar; and get the weather forecast.

Take Monday morning double maths in your stride

The Oxford vision maths set was developed in conjunction with RNIB, and has been specially designed to meet the needs of those with a vision impairment.

It has a high contrast, yellow and black design with tactile elements to make it easier to read. The large print graduations on the 15cm ruler, 45 and 60 degree set squares, and 180 degree protractor are raised 0.5mm so they can be felt, and marked in black on the yellow plastic to make them easier to read. There are also notches in the side and non-slip pads on the back of these tools to allow for easy use.

The set comprises: self-centring metal compass with safety point, 9cm graphite pencil for use in compass, PVC and phthalate-free eraser, pencil sharpener with antitamper screw, 15cm ruler, 45 and 60 degree set squares, 180 degree protractor, 10mm lettering stencil, and storage tin.

ARx AI updates

If you've fancied buying an ARx AI headset but were put off by either the price or the need to have an Android phone, we've got great news for you.

First, the headset (HT398) is now available for £599.00 / £718.80 – not an offer price or a sale price, just a lower price!

And secondly, you can now buy an ARx iPhone adaptor to use with the headset if you have an iPhone or iPad with a USB-C port...



ARx iPhone adaptor

The ARx iPhone adaptor makes the ARx AI v1.5 headset compatible with the iPhone 15 and above, as well as iPads with a USB-C port. The adaptor comes with enhanced audio and is designed to be low energy.

The ARx iOS adapter fully leverages the audio output of the iPhone 15 with enhanced audio volume and quality. This will allow users to fully benefit from the bone-conduction speakers, even in noisy areas.

The adaptor's bespoke integration into the Apple ecosystem, means hardware app permissions are no longer required, making it easier to use ARx on the go.

Meet the versatile VoxiVision

This small, portable device can read any text – including handwriting – out loud, and also functions as a video magnifier, voice recorder, barcode and label reader, and colour and banknote detector.

About the size of a smartphone, this easy-to-use device can be used anywhere and controlled by tactile buttons, voice controls or hand gestures.

VoxiVision can capture and read up to A4-size documents. It doesn't require an internet connection for most text, so it can be used on the go



to read letters, books, street signs and information from screens. (To read handwriting accurately, you will need to connect the device to the internet.) You can use VoxiVision handheld or place it in the supplied stand to use as a standalone reader.

When used in the stand, the VoxiVision can be controlled using the supplied remote and voice control, or by hand gestures (for example, placing your right hand, flat, above the document will pause or resume reading).

In autoplay mode, simply position the document using the guide on the stand and when the VoxiVision detects that you have removed your hands, automatic reading will begin. Use voice commands or hand gestures to control playback.

The VoxiVision has three tactile buttons to guide you when you go handheld and use the touchscreen to navigate.

Use this device to read tables and multi-column documents; save and store multi-page documents; transfer documents to your computer;

translate documents, extract information such as email addresses and phone numbers; and to spell words out for you.

Functions can be modelled to suit you – choose all the features or just the ones you want. Connect via Bluetooth to headphones or a speaker for privacy or more volume.

In addition to its text-to-speech function, you can ask the device to analyse an image. For example: TV guide – "What time and channel is Midsomer Murders on?", or Menu – "How much does the green salad cost?"

As a handheld video magnifier, it offers a 6.6-inch screen and a magnification range up to 25× with a smooth, continuous zoom. Use for close viewing and distance magnification. Save and store information for later viewing. Enlarge saved images and pan using your finger on the screen. Choose from a selection of colour modes to make viewing easier.

The barcode reader can identify more than 70,000 items and will allow you to add previously unrecognised barcodes. You can also add voice notes to barcodes, for example, instructions for medication, so they can be accessed again in future.

The VoxiVision can also be used to identify banknotes (Pounds Sterling, Euros, US Dollars, Canadian Dollars, Swiss Francs, Swedish Krona and Danish Krone) and as a colour detector.

The VoxiVision is supplied with 50 reusable tags that you can use to record audio labels. (Tags are cold and humidity-resistant, so can be used to tag food in fridges and freezers. Record up to one minute of audio per tag.)

You can also record up to 90 minutes of audio using the device's voice recorder.

Please note that although the VoxiVision uses smartphone hardware, it can not be used as a fully functioning mobile phone.

you may prefer the CloverBook Plus. This 12.5-inch portable video magnifier produces high quality images, can be used for distance and self-view viewing as well as close-up magnification, and can be controlled by tactile buttons or the touchscreen.

The lightweight design enables you to take the CloverBook Plus with you wherever you go, while the integrated foldable arm allows you to quickly set the magnifier up as a desktop device with room to write underneath it, if required.

The tactile controls and touchscreen allow you to zoom and pan around live view or captured images.

This magnifier can be used in educational and work settings for reading and writing at a desk and viewing whiteboards. The portable design makes it easy to move between class, work and home. And use the CloverBook Plus at home for reading, paperwork, puzzles, checking food and medication packaging, and even as a magnifying mirror, thanks to the self-view function.

Dot Pad is a smart, real-time tactile graphics display that enables blind and partially sighted users to access visual content from any source.



It instantly converts any input on a connected device into a tactile graphic – including handwriting, sketches, signatures, graphs, maps, diagrams and photos – that you can interact with and explore in detail.

Dot Pad connects to devices via Bluetooth, and has simple, intuitive controls and a 20-cell text-to-braille panel in addition to 2,400 pins in the tactile graphic panel. (The panel can accommodate 300 braille glyphs, in addition to the 20-cell braille panel below the controls.) Dot Pad's cells are powered by the innovative Dot actuator technology: ten times smaller, lighter, and more energy efficient than conventional braille devices.



Dot Pad is compatible with many Apple devices (iOS & iPadOS 15.2 and higher) and integrates with VoiceOver to provide additional screen reading capabilities. Connect to iPhone or iPad via Bluetooth or USB-C cable (no additional apps required).

Dot Pad also works with Windows 11 with NVDA (JAWS support coming in 2025). Roughly the size of a laptop, and weighing 1.2kg, the Dot Pad is also extremely portable.

The six freely assignable tactile buttons allow you to explore images by inverting, zooming, rotating and panning them.

Get better braille

The Index Basic-D V5 Embosser is a compact and powerful tractor-fed braille printer that has been updated with new features, including wi-fi connectivity, embossing from USB memory sticks, and from mobile devices.





Producing 140 characters per second, this popular, compact embosser turns out single and double-sided braille and can be used with our 135gsm tractor-fed embosser paper (BP41).

This updated Basic-D V5 is compatible with mainstream technology and features the latest braille techniques as well as improved braille quality from the V5 solenoids – these offer even better braille dot quality, a longer life cycle, higher embossing speed and lower power consumption. It is also possible to clean paper dust off the solenoids.

You can select and save region specific layouts or operate using 1-9 layout options, including user-



defined. You can also emboss braille horizontally or vertically (sideways) on the page.

The control panel has keys labelled in text and braille; arrows and OK keys for menu control; backlit keys (on, help, and menu), icons and text; a speaker for speech feedback; connectors for sensors, fan and motors; and braille tray door control.

In addition to backlit keys, icons and text, there is an LED light in the embosser head area.

The Index BrailleApp is included free-of-charge, for an unlimited number of users and allows you preview, edit and save braille documents on your devices when the embosser is connected to your network. You can also use the app to update firmware; monitor the status of the embosser, network, Bluetooth and USB memory stick; and for setting up network and Bluetooth connections. It's easy to use, and no license or registration is required. Index BrailleApp supports all major operation systems such as Windows, iOS, Android, Linux, and Unix, and all major browsers such as Internet Explorer, Safari, and Firefox.


The embosser also has Index's own, free direct braille printing application built in. idB is compatible with Windows, Mac and Linux computers and gives you endless embossing options from your smartphone, tablet or portable PC. Simply select the file (doc, docx, pdf or epub) and send it to the embosser – idB translates and formats into contracted or uncontracted braille, for embossing. (idB supports page numbering and uses the resources in the Liblouis open source project).
